18<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost (6<sup>th</sup> of Luke) Martyr Nestor of Thessalonica

#### "Lord I Call..." Tone 1

Lord, I call upon Thee, hear me! Hear me, O Lord!
Lord, I call upon Thee, hear me!
Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon Thee!//
Hear me, O Lord!

Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Thy sight as <u>in</u>cense, and <u>let</u> the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an <u>eve</u>ning <u>sac</u>rifice!// Hear me, O Lord!

**V.** (10) *Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Thy Name.* 

### **Tone 1** *(for the Resurrection)*

Ac<u>cept</u> our evening prayers, O <u>ho</u>ly Lord! Grant us re<u>mis</u>sion of sins,// for Thou alone hast manifested the Resurrection to the world.

V. (9) The righteous will surround me, for Thou wilt deal bountifully with me.

Encircle Zion and surround her, O people!
Give glory in her to the One Who rose from the dead!
For He is our God,//
Who has delivered us from our transgressions!

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to Thee, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

Come, O people, let us hymn and fall down before Christ, glorifying His Resurrection from the dead! For He is our God,//
Who has delivered the world from the Enemy's deceit!

V. (7) Let Thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

(Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

Be glad, O heavens!
Sound trumpets, O foundations of the earth!
Sing in gladness, O mountains!
Behold Emmanuel has nailed our sins to the Cross!
Granting life, He has slain death.//
He has resurrected Adam as the Lover of man.

**V.** (6) *If Thou, O Lord, shouldst mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with Thee.* 

## Let us praise Him

Who voluntarily was crucified in the <u>flesh</u> for our sake. He <u>suffered</u>, was buried, but <u>rose</u> from the dead. By Orthodoxy con<u>firm</u> Thy <u>Church</u>, O Christ.// Grant peace for our life as the gracious <u>Lov</u>er of man.

**V.** (5) For Thy Name's sake I wait for Thee, O Lord. My soul has waited for Thy word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

We <u>stand</u> before Thy life-bearing tomb unworthily, O <u>Christ</u> God, offering glory to Thine ineffable com<u>passion</u>. Thou hast ac<u>cept</u>ed the Cross and death, O <u>sin</u>less One// to grant Resurrection to the world as the <u>Lov</u>er of man.

**V.** (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

Let us praise the Word, co-eternal with the <u>Fa</u>ther.

He in<u>eff</u>ably came forth from the <u>virginal</u> womb.

He freely accepted the <u>Cross</u> and <u>death</u> for our sake.

He was <u>raised</u> in <u>glo</u>ry.//

Glory to Thee, O life-giving Lord, the <u>Sav</u>ior of our souls!

**V.** (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

### **Tone 8** (for St. Nestor) (Oh, most glorious wonder)

O <u>glor</u>ious sufferer <u>Nes</u>tor, girding thyself in all the <u>ar</u>mor of Christ, thou didst grapple with the visible Ly<u>é</u>us and de<u>stroy</u> him, while thou didst trap the invisible Belial with invisible arrows and <u>slay</u> him.// Therefore the bountiful One has crowned thee with a wreath of <u>vic</u>tory.

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

<u>Strength</u>ened with divine words, O wise <u>Nes</u>tor, with true courage thou didst kill the proud tormentor of the martyr De<u>me</u>trius. Confessing the immortal God Who <u>died</u> and <u>har</u>rowed hell, thou didst suffer an unjust death, O <u>glo</u>rious one.//
Therefore, rejoicing, thou hast inherited everlasting life.

**V.** (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

<u>Thou</u> wast a godly youth, radiant in physical beauty and <u>power</u>, and wast adorned with divine grace and noble <u>courage</u>; therefore thou didst throw down the might of Lyæus by the <u>power</u> of the Al<u>mighty</u>. Thou didst suffer, rejoicing, and hast been numbered with the choirs of those who <u>struggled</u>.// As thou dost rejoice with them, ever re<u>mem</u>ber us!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

# **Tone 1** (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

Let us <u>praise</u> the Virgin <u>Mary!</u>
The gate of heaven, the <u>glory</u> of the world!
The <u>song</u> of the angels, the beauty of the <u>faithful!</u>
She was born of <u>man</u>, yet gave <u>birth</u> to God!
She was re<u>vealed</u> as the heaven, as the temple of the <u>God</u>head!
She destroyed the wall of <u>en</u>mity!
She com<u>menced</u> the peace; she opened the <u>Kingdom!</u>
Since she is <u>our foundation</u> of faith,
our defender is the <u>Lord</u> Whom she bore!
Courage! Courage! O <u>Peop</u>le of God!
For <u>Christ</u> will destroy our <u>en</u>emies//
since He is all powerful.

We have been <u>freed</u> from <u>suf</u>ferings by Thy <u>suf</u>fering, O Christ. <u>We</u> have been delivered from cor<u>rup</u>tion by Thy <u>Res</u>ur<u>rec</u>tion.// O Lord, glory to Thee!

**V**. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

Let creation rejoice!
Let the <u>heavens</u> be glad!
Let the <u>nations</u> clap their hands with <u>gladness</u>, for Christ our Savior has <u>nailed</u> our <u>sins</u> to the Cross. Slaying <u>death</u>, He has given <u>life</u>.//
He has resurrected fallen Adam as the Lover of man.

**V**. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

As <u>King</u> of <u>heaven</u> and earth,
Thou wast voluntarily crucified in Thy <u>love</u> for man.

<u>Hell</u> was angered when it <u>met</u> Thee below.

Adam rose seeing Thee, the Creator, <u>un</u>der the earth.

O <u>won</u>der! How has the Life of all <u>tasted</u> death?

Thou didst enlighten the <u>world</u> which cries://

O Lord, Who didst rise from the dead, <u>glory</u> to Thee!

V. Holiness befits Thy house, O Lord, forevermore!

The <u>myrrh</u>bearing women came with <u>haste</u> to Thy tomb, bearing myrrh and la<u>menting</u>.

Not <u>finding</u> Thy most pure <u>body</u>, they learned from the angel of the new and <u>glo</u>rious <u>won</u>der. They <u>told</u> the A<u>pos</u>tles://

"The Lord is risen, granting the world great mercy."

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

**Tone 1** (*Theotokion*)

Behold, Isaiah's prophecy is fulfilled, for the Virgin gave birth, yet remained a Virgin!

God was born, and so nature was restored anew.

Do not despise the entreaties of thy servants, O Mother of God!

We offer them to thee in thy temple.

Since thou hast carried in thine arms the compassionate One, have compassion on thy servants,//
and pray that our souls may be saved.

Mary, full of grace, the <u>Lord</u> is with thee!
Blessed art thou among <u>wo</u>men,
and blessed is the <u>Fruit</u> of thy womb,//
for thou hast borne the Savior of our souls. (thrice)

Having <u>fought</u> the <u>good</u> fight, thou didst win immortal glory, O <u>Nes</u>tor.

Thou didst be<u>come</u> a perfect soldier for the <u>Mas</u>ter through the prayers of the martyr De<u>me</u>trius.//

Together with him thou art praying unceasingly to <u>Christ God</u> for us all.

#### Tone 1 Prokeimenon (Resurrection)

Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee! (Ps. 32:22)

V. Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just! (Ps. 32:1)
